Drive on century old horse and wagon trails through deep woods conditions to reach your campsite by a natural spring-fed lake that can only be accessed by "all terrain" vehicles. Everyone from beginners to well seasoned campers are welcomed to join this exciting outdoor adventure. If you own your own ATV you're welcome to come along!

You'll get to go where most Canadians never get to go....deep into Haliburton's back country forest. At the end of your first day you'll enjoy some down time to do what you want like swimming, tanning, or enjoying some of the best fishing around!

So picture yourself with your partner, family or friends camping at the end of an exciting day in front of a lake under a blanket of stars by a roaring fire before you awake the next day to hit the trails again!

### Convoy's Route

**Day & Time:** Safari members must reach designated meeting place on a **Monday** at 11:00am sharp. We return back to the meeting place on a **Tuesday** afternoon.

\*Own ATV with guide \$150.00/person

\*Minimum Age Requirement- 16 and older

### Safari Convoy Bookings

All convoys must be booked at least 3-4 weeks in advance. A nonrefundable deposit of 50% of convoy cost per person is required upon booking. The remaining fee is to be paid to guide on arrival for safari convoy.

### **What We Supply**

- 16 fully automatic ATVs
- helmets
- gas/diesel (for our vehicles only)
- first aid kit
- environmentally friendly soap and shampoo
- drinking water
- cooler
- cooking equipment and utensils
- condiments, seasonings
- Food: muffins, marshmallows, fruits, coffee, tea and juices and dinner by campsite on Monday
- portable BBQ
- firewood
- 2 man tent
- fishing rods and tackle
- garbage bags (what we bring MUST leave with us)
- one to four guides depending on size of convoy

### **What You Need to Bring**

Due to limited space, restrictions are as follows:

- 1 back pack per person
- 1 sleeping bag per person
- clothing: rain gear, swimming shorts /bathing-suit, one towel & change of clothes
- please wear enclosed shoes like sneakers, long sleeve tops and pants for trails
- bug spray
- personal products
- health card, drivers license
- money to buy personal things when we stop off in town

### **What NOT to Bring or Do**

- No fuel lanterns (flashlights recommended)
- No glass
- No guns
- No coolers
- No fireworks
- No littering
- No drugs

### **Rules**

- Age Requirement- 16 and older

- For your own safety, everyone MUST listen to and obey their guide's directions and instruction. Reckless behavior can lead to the cancellation or shortening of trip without refund.
- All valuables stay with if you
- We are NOT responsible for the lost or theft of your goods
- Garbage must NOT be left behind
- Pack for 1 night, but pack carefully and thoughtfully as we have limited carrying space. We reserve the right to limit what you bring.
- All convoy members are required to sign waiver forms to participate or be a part of the safari convoy.
- If you have a medical condition, injury or are pregnant, this adventure is NOT for you.
